This polygon shapefile holds records for vascular plants, charophytes and the one lichen species listed in the Flora (Protection) Order 2022.

Records are presented as squares with side lengths corresponding to the resolution (1x1m to 10x10km) in which the observations were recorded.

Please note that records for sensitive species are obscured to hectad (10x10km) resolution - see attribute field <Sensitive_Species>.

This shapefile contains records for vascular plants, charophytes and lichens listed in the Flora (Protection) Order 2022.

The records have been extracted from the NPWS species database, which is a SQL server database managed using Recorder 6 software, and linked to taxon dictionaries which are supplied by the National Biodiversity Network (NBN), the Natural History Museum (NHM) and the Joint Nature Conservation Committee (JNCC).

Quality checks have been carried out by the NPWS Vascular plants expert, and records of sensitive species have been obscured to hectad (10x10km) resolution.
