Dear Sir/Madam,

I believe Ireland's roads are classified as follows:

National Primary Roads N1 to N50. National Secondary Roads N51 to N99. Regional Roads R100 to R999. Local Primary Roads L1000 to L4999. Local Secondary Roads L5000 to L8999. Local Tertiary Roads L10001 to L89999.

In the interests of road safety, I propose an amendment regarding cutting of roadside hedges. All road numbers classified as beginning with an N(M) and R, the closed period should be altered to 01 April to 31 July and for all other roads (i.e those beginning with an L) the closed period remains as it is at present 01 April to 31 August.
