I wish to refer to the letter from Mr Mark Bohan of the National Parks & Wildlife Service regarding the review to be carried out by the Minister of Arts, Heritage & the Gaeltacht of the legislative Controls set out in Section 40 of the Wildlife Acts 1976 to 2012 governing the control of burning & hedge cutting.

Tipperary County Council welcomes the opportunity to respond to the request for its views or suggestions in regard to this review process.

The Council would be in favour of extending the period in which Roadside hedges are allowed to be trimmed for Road Safety & Road Maintenance reasons from the current period of the 31 August to 28th February to a new period commencing on 31 July until the 28th February.

We would appreciate if you would include this submission when reviewing the legislative controls of section 40 of Wildlife Acts 1976 to 2012.
