One hare was caught/pinned by one of the dogs circa 25 meters from the escape entrance. This hare was quickly taken from the dog by the local coursing officials. It appears the dog could “pinch” the skin of the hare enough to hold it. This hare was later examined by a Vet who determined this hare had no injuries. Note this hare had what appeared to be lesions around the snout and mouth. I enquired from the Vet what this evidence indicated. ■■■ stated it is a condition called Orf. Later the Vet gave this hare an injection. I enquired what the medicine was – the vet stated it was Metacam

- One of the pinned hares was inspected by the Vet and appeared to be healthy at that time. However, when this animal was taken from the box for release, it could not move its hind legs. At that point the local coursing official and the NPWS ranger contacted the Vet immediately to re-examine this particular animal. The Vet re-inspected this hare and determined it had a broken back. This animal was then euthanized by the Vet. I observed the dead hare.
- Note: Re: Q 8; no hares were found dead in the paddock. Moreover, there was an agreement that if any of the Hares found was found dead, this matter would be reported immediately to the attending NPWS staff.


