





Day One started at 11.20 and there was a very small attendance due to the Covid 19 Regulations and there was no admission to spectators or public. Only dog owners and club officials were in attendance. The weather was cold, wet and dull. The event was well organised and Club members were welcoming and courteous in our dealings with them.

The Hares were in good condition and well trained and familiar with the escapes etc. The course stewards could have intervened faster when Hares were turned to prevent some of them being hit on occasion. The event ran smoothly and without incident.

**Covid 19 regulations** were well adhered to around the course with lots of ‘Social Distance’ signage places around the course. There was no admission without wearing masks and the MC on both days regularly reminded people about Social Distancing, wearing masks and using of hand sanitizers around the course. No public were permitted to attend so as to keep the numbers below the max permitted (50) under the Covid 19 Regs.

The hares were checked, counted and placed into boxes for immediate release shortly after the event concluded. They were not marked at this stage as they had been ear tagged before the event.


The hares divided between three club members to be released in the respective areas that they were caught.
