Sunday 27/02/2022 attended by [REDACTED]

Two hares were pinned on 27th of February. One was released by the dogs before it could be boxed, it returned to the escape unaided. The second pinned hare was assessed and cleared as uninjured by the vet. Two hares were reported as being pinned on the 26th of February and assessed by the vet. The vet advised that they should be released. These hares were released in [REDACTED] NPWS were not notified of this release until the following day.

On Sunday 27th of February 3 hares were released in [REDACTED] before NPWS staff were in position to observe.
