No NPWS staff were present on day one (Friday).
The meeting was attended by the and District Conservation Officer n day two of the meeting (Saturday). On arrival at approximately 10:45am the hares were boxed and counted by NPWS staff. 51 hares were boxed and all had ear tags. After the hares were counted NPWS staff had requested that all pinned hares to be boxed for examination by the Veterinary Inspector after a pin. There were 40 courses ran for the day along with one 2 uncoursed hares run and 2 Reserves run. One hare fell against the wire on the run out to the course but was able to complete the course unaided. The 7 hares that were not coursed were released back to the hare park and not ran on the course.
Day three of the coursing event was attended by 10:30am the hares were boxed and counted by NPWS staff. 51 Hares were boxed and all had ear tags. There were 38 courses during the day along with two uncoursed hares ran. 3 hares were hit but all three ran into the hare park unaided. One hare was pinned, it was immediately boxed and examined by the Veterinary Inspector during the interval and again at the end of the day prior to release.
After the event hares were boxed and divided into two cohorts with one NPWS Staff member present with each cohort for transport to the release sites. Cohort 1 releases were supervised by as follows:
