

Notes:

At approximately 10:50am, a total of 46 hares were counted boxed in the boxing shed as declared on the original hare capture return form. The hares appearance looked to be ok. Upon inspection of the hare park an additional hare was found lying up which appeared to be unwell/injured. It then ran to the other side of the enclosure.

Coursing commenced at approximately 11:30 am.

A total of 7 hares were ran up the coursing field.

The first hare was hit, pinned, and held and had to be secured from the dog(s) by the stewards/handlers.

The second hare was a no slip and was not coursed.

The third hare was hit and pinned but quickly freed itself to escape the coursing field.

The fourth hare was hit, pinned and held and had to be secured from the dog(s) by the stewards/handlers.

The fifth hare was hit, pinned and held and had to be secured from the dog(s) by the stewards/handlers (From memory, at this point the slipper stopped the coursing and discussion was made as to what to do next).

A sixth hare was subsequently let run up the course but the dogs were not slipped.

A seventh hare was hit, pinned, and held and had to be secured from the dog(s) by the stewards/handlers.

Each dog retained its muzzle when slipped, none came off if/when in contact with a hare.

At this point (11:50) the [REDACTED], the slipper and stewards had a discussion on the condition of the hares. This three day meeting was then called off/suspended with a view to assessing the situation and the possibility of reorganising the meet two weeks later. The vet then examined 3 hares in the boxing shed at 12:00-12:10 and suggested the possibility of a viral pneumonia.

Subsequent communications with the [REDACTED] confirmed that no pneumonia or infection was found in the hares upon examination by two vets that evening. The hares were then given an injection.

On 22nd December the [REDACTED] was contacted and they confirmed that the hares had got their third injection that day and they seemed to be clearing up health wise. The ICC vets were going to assess the hares the following Monday 27th with a view to running the meeting on the 3rd and 4th January 2022.

On 29th December the [REDACTED] was contacted and they confirmed that the hares had been tested by the ICC and all was well. All 47 hares were still alive and in the possession of the club.

This meeting was then reorganised and run on the 3rd and 4th January 2022.
