The meeting was attended by the [REDACTED] n day one of the meeting (Saturday). On arrival at approximately 10:30am the hares were boxed and counted by NPWS staff. 51 hares were boxed and all had ear tags. After the hares were counted NPWS staff requested that all pinned hares are to be boxed for examination by the Veterinary Inspector. There were 42 courses run on the day along with 4 Reserves and 5 uncoursed hares. 1 hare was hit during the reserve run but ran into the hare park unaided.

Day two of the coursing event (Sunday) was attended by [REDACTED] On arrival at approximately 11am the hares were boxed and counted by NPWS staff. All 51 Hares were boxed and all had ear tags. There were 38 courses during the day. One hare was pinned during the event, was boxed and examined by the Veterinary Inspector during the interval and again at the end of the day prior to release. 3 hares were hit but all ran into the hare park unaided.

After the event hares were boxed and transported to the release sites. One hare was reported to NPWS staff as having escaped while being brought to the boxing unit and was not recaptured.
