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The meeting was attended by the [REDACTED] on day one of the meeting (Friday). On arrival at approximately 10:45am the hares were boxed and counted by NPWS staff. 42 hares were boxed and all had ear tags. After the hares were counted NPWS staff had requested that all pinned hares to be boxed for examination by the Veterinary Inspector after a pin. There were 32 courses ran for the day along with one 1 uncoursed hare run and 6 Reserves run. Two hares were hit during the event but both ran into the hare park uninjured. The hare pinned on day one was released by the hare steward into the hare park after being separated from the dogs.

No NPWS staff were present on day two (Saturday).

Day three of the coursing event was attended by [REDACTED] On arrival at approximately 10:30am the hares were boxed and counted by NPWS staff. 42 Hares were boxed and all had ear tags. There were 27 courses during the day. One hare was hit but ran into the hare park uninjured.

After the event hares were boxed and divided into two cohorts for transport to the release sites. One group of hares went to [REDACTED] the other went for release in [REDACTED] The releases were fully supervised by NPWS staff. 7 Hares released with supervision by [REDACTED] [REDACTED] released with supervision by [REDACTED]
