WILDLIFE (WILD MAMMALS) (OPEN SEASONS) ORDER, 2005.

The Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Sections 8(2) of the <u>Wildlife Act, 1976</u> (No. 39 of 1976), and the Heritage (Transfer of Departmental Administration and Ministerial Functions) Order, 2002 (<u>S.I. No. 356 of 2002</u>) hereby orders as follows:

- This Order may be cited as the Wildlife (Wild Mammals) (Open Seasons Order, 2005)
 Seasons) Order, 2005.
- 2. In this Order a reference to a column is to a column of the Schedule to this Order.
- 3. The species of protected wild mammals specified in column (1) may be hunted during the periods specified in relation to the species concerned in column (2), in the manner so specified in column (3), in the places in the State so specified in column (4).
- 4. For the purposes of this order Antlerless Deer will be construed as including any male deer without antlers, of less than one year, i.e. a calf
- 5. The Wildlife (Wild Mammals) (Open Seasons) Order, 1998 (<u>S.I. No. 331 of 1998</u>), is hereby revoked.
