

BALLYNESS BAY SPECIAL AREA OF CONSERVATION (CONTROL OF
RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES) DIRECTION 2010

WHEREAS it appears to the Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government that certain recreational activities being carried out in the Ballyness Bay Special Area of Conservation 1090 are:


- a. likely to have an adverse effect on the integrity of a European Site, or
- b. likely to cause the deterioration of natural habitats or the habitats of species or the disturbance of the species for which the European Site has been designated pursuant to the Habitats Directive or has been classified pursuant to the Birds Directive, in so far as such disturbance could be significant in relation to the objectives of the Habitats Directive, or
- c. likely to cause pollution or deterioration of habitats within the meaning of the second sentence of Article 4.4 of the Birds Directive

NOW, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Regulation 8 (1) of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) (Control of Recreational Activities) Regulations 2010, the Minister for the Environment, Heritage and Local Government thereby directs that the following recreational activities shall not be carried out, caused or permitted to be carried out or continue to be carried out by any person in the European Site or part thereof or at any other land as specified in the attached maps.

1. Use of All Terrain and Off Road Vehicles, including:
 - Quad Bikes
 - Scrambler Bikes
 - 4x4 vehicles
