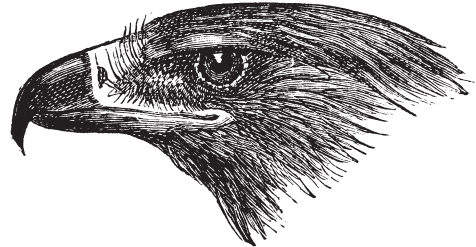


# Beaks

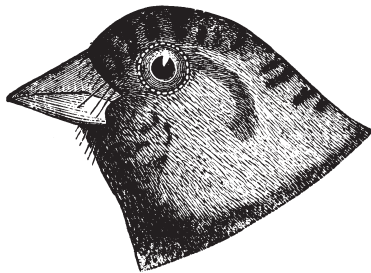
Beaks come in an enormous range of shapes and sizes.

holes.

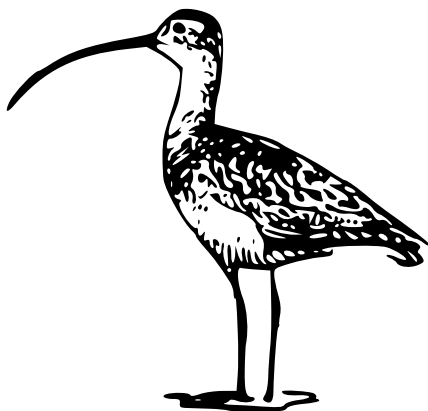
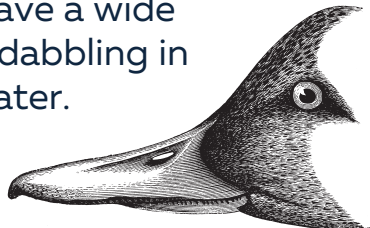


For Meat
