

### Derogation Number DER-NATTERJACK TOAD-2025-02

# EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (BIRDS AND NATURAL HABITATS) REGULATIONS, 2011 (S.I. No 477 of 2011)

#### DEROGATION

Granted under Regulation 54 of the European Communities (Birds and Natural Habitats) Regulations 2011, hereinafter referred to as "the Habitats Regulations".

The Minister for Housing, Local Government & Heritage, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Regulation 54 of the Habitats Regulations hereby grants to **Rachel Haynes**, Kevin **Culleton**, Amy Heijerman, Kristine Otteson, Thijs Tooley, Kevin Culleton, Amy Heijerman, Kristine Otteson, Thijs Tooley of 82 Fairway Heights, Knockanacuig, Tralee, Co.Kerry, V92W597 a derogation. It is stated that this derogation is issued:

- A. For the purpose of research and education, of re-populating and re-introducing these species and for the breeding operations necessary for these purposes, including artificial propagation of plants
- B. As there is no satisfactory alternative, and the action authorised by this derogation will not be detrimental to the maintenance of the population of **<u>bats</u>** referred to below at a favourable conservation status in their natural range.

The derogation is issued in respect of Natterjack Toad (Epidalea calamita)

This derogation authorises the following:

#### Terms and Conditions

- 1. This derogation is granted solely to allow the activities specified in connection with the works located at 82 Fairway Heights, Knockanacuig, Tralee, Co.Kerry, V92W597, for Rachel Haynes, Kevin Culleton, Amy Heijerman, Kristine Otteson, Thijs Tooley.
- 2. All activities authorised by this derogation, and all equipment used in connection herewith, shall be carried out, constructed and maintained (as the case may be) so as to avoid unnecessary injury or distress to any **NATTERJACK TOAD**.
- 3. This derogation may be modified or revoked, for stated reasons, at any time.
- 4. The mitigation measures outlined in the application report (**Natterjack Toad Ireland**), together with any changes or clarification agreed in correspondence between NPWS and the agent or applicant, are to be carried out. Strict adherence must be paid to all the proposed measures in the application.
- The actions which this derogation authorise shall be completed between the 07<sup>TH</sup> May 2025 and 31<sup>st</sup> July 2025, inclusive.
- 6. The works will be supervised by ecologist Rachel Haynes
- 7. If this derogation addresses works that are subject of a planning application, no such works permitted under this derogation can occur until planning permission is granted.
- 8. If this derogation expires prior to works permitted under this derogation commencing, a new application must be sought in advance, including the provision of any updated data or reports.
- 9. This derogation shall be produced for inspection on a request being made on that behalf by a member of An Garda Síochána or an authorised NPWS officer appointed under Regulation 4 of the Habitats Regulations.
- The local National Parks and Wildlife Service field officer District Conservation
  Officer, <u>William.Hunt@npws.gov.ie</u>, should be contacted prior to the commencement of any activity.
- 11. On completion of the activities authorised by this derogation, a report must be submitted to <u>Wildlife.reports@NPWS.gov.ie</u> detailing results of works and success of mitigation within four weeks of the expiry date of this derogation.
- 12. On completion of the actions which this derogation authorises, all recordings of bat species affected will be made using the standardised data form provided below and must be submitted to the NPWS within four weeks of the expiry date of this derogation. Included with the below returns form, a report will also be submitted to <u>Wildlife.reports@NPWS.gov.ie</u> detailing results of works and success of mitigation. Both documents must be submitted to constitute a derogation return.
