WILDLIFE ACT, 1976 (AS AMENDED) – SECTION 32

**LICENCE TO ATTACH A TAG OR OTHER MARKING DEVICE TO A WILD
ANIMAL**

The Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage (hereinafter referred to as “the Minister”), in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Sections 9 and 32 of the Wildlife Act, 1976 (No. 39 of 1976), as adapted, authorises the **IRISH COURSING CLUB** (“the Licensee”), Davis Road, Clonmel, Co. Tipperary to attach a tag or other marking device as specified in Column 1 of the Schedule hereunder to hares taken in accordance with a licence issued under Section 34 of the Wildlife Acts during the period beginning on the 14th day of August 2021 and ending on the 28th day of February 2022 subject to the attached conditions. The authority given by the Licence shall be exercisable by the Licensee and by the Coursing Clubs listed in the schedule attached hereto.

CONDITIONS:

1. The Licence shall be produced for inspection on a request being made on that behalf by a member of the Garda Síochána or any person appointed by the Minister under Section 72 of the Wildlife Act, 1976 (as amended), to be an authorised person for the purposes of the said Act.
2. The Minister may amend or revoke the Licence at any time.
3. A return giving particulars of hares tagged or marked on foot of this licence shall be made to the Minister within 4 weeks of the expiry of the period of validity of the Licence or on a request being made in that behalf by the Minister.
4. The Licensee, the Coursing Clubs affiliated to the Licensee and the Members of such clubs must comply with Section 44 of the Wildlife Acts and must obtain the permission, either of the person who is the owner or the occupier of the land or, in cases where some other person is entitled to enjoy sporting rights over the land, that other person, prior to entering on any land for the purpose of hunting or catching or tagging hares.
5. If sick or dead hares are encountered during the netting period or within the hare parks, National Parks and Wildlife Service staff should be notified immediately.
6. The ICC and its affiliated clubs shall collaborate with the Department and the contractor on the Study to be undertaken on the Monitoring and Research on Hare Movements and Survival after Coursing.
7. The ICC should ensure that its clubs and membership adhere fully to all guidance in respect of Covid-19 and that it has the necessary protocols in place to ensure full compliance with these.

Note: This Licence does not authorise any person to enter on any land without the permission of the owner or occupier of the land.
