A second roost building was entered on Porterstown Road (108 Leisler's bats) but no bats were within the attic entered and no bats were disturbed. All other roosts (a stable, a rocket box and Schwegler bat boxes or on our farm at Golashane Nature Reserve. Two bats (soprano pipistrelles) were handled and a total of 9 soprano pipistrelles, one Natterer's bat, one Daubenton's bat and one brown long-eared bat have been noted
