How do you identify a tree? Look for the clues...

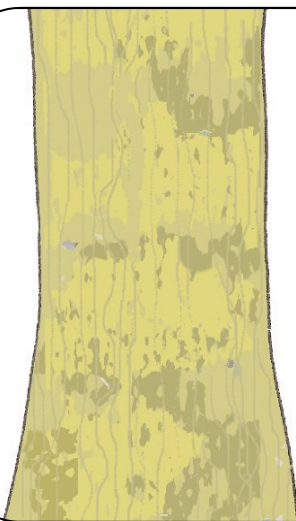
Study some of the trees growing in the woodland. Compare their leaves, seeds, bark or buds with the Ash tree's below.

Can you find a match?



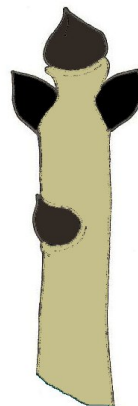
The leaves are green in summer and turn brown before falling off in autumn.

The seeds form during the summer and can be left hanging on the trees like a bunch of keys throughout the winter until next spring



The bark can be smooth when the tree is young but it forms cracks and lines when it gets older.

The bark is usually light brown/blonde.



The buds are black and form in pairs on opposite sides of the twig.
