NPWS Sensitive Species List

NPWS sensitive data are defined as any data that NPWS does not wish to make publicly available, e.g. precise localities of endangered species.

NPWS considers records relating to the following species as sensitive data:

Leiocolea rutheana (Norfolk flapwort)	Few localities, sensitive habitat
Oedipodium griffithianum (Gouty-moss)	Few localities, sensitive habitat
Margaritifera margaritifera (Freshwater pearl mussel)	Potential threat of collection
Margaritifera durrovensis (Nore pearl mussel)	Potential threat of collection
Alcedo atthis (Kingfisher)	Few localities, sensitive habitat
