### Other Site Characteristics

A small oak wood on the eastern flank of a ridge of quartzite hills, with a terrain of rocky ridges separated by narrow, sometimes marshy defiles. A soil cover of glacial drift varies in thickness and gives rise to a diversity of woodland structural and floristic elements.

### 4.2 Quality and importance

One of the few remaining semi-natural oak woods in north-west Ireland, forming an important link in the national network of woodland reserves. Contains good quality oak wood of the Blechno-Quercetum petraea coryletosum with a diverse range of structural elements.
